In-Person Watch Party Guide

Steps to Schedule and Host Your In-Person Watch Party

1. 2. Invite family, friends, and colleagues to your watch party by sending an invitation for the event using the details below:

Perseverance in Hope: The 2020 Joseph's Home Benefit Luncheon is an annual event that celebrates the remarkable healing and achievements of the medically fragile men experiencing homelessness who have stabilized their health and transformed their lives at Joseph's Home. They will be broadcasting the event live on October 28, 2020 with the hope of raising awareness of this vital ministry and critical funds needed to support the complex needs of the men we serve.

I am hosting a watch party for the 2020 Perseverance in Hope Joseph's Home Benefit Luncheon and I would love for you to join me! Here are the details:

Watch Party Date (October 28)

Watch Party Start Time (The Luncheon will broadcast at noon on October 28, but feel free to gather your guests before then)

Watch Party Location

Last year and with the help of many supporters, they raised over \$52,000 to benefit Joseph's Home! This year, they are aiming to raise \$60,000 in 2020!

Every dollar raised will help end the cycle of streets, hospitalization and shelter for medically-fragile adults without housing by treating their acute conditions, connecting them to appropriate ongoing healthcare and working with our housing partners to obtain a stable, permanent home with ongoing supports to maintain medical and housing stability.

3. Figure out how you will show the Virtual Luncheon. We suggest connecting a laptop to your television or projector and speakers for easy (and socially-distanced) watching. We recommend doing attest-run to make sure your technology is working correctly!
4. On the day of the event, welcome your guests to your watch party and give a brief description of Joseph's Home- who we are, what we do, and how they can get involved. Make sure to encourage them to be a part of the fun by texting to give during the program!

Tips for hosting an in-person watch party for the Luncheon:

1. Follow CDC guidelines
 - No handshaking
 - Remain 6 ft. Apart
 - Wear mask when social distancing is not possible
2. Keep a list of all guest. So, if someone comes in contact with COVID-19 it will be easy to know who to contact
3. Limit the number of people handling food
4. **Test the audio before your webinar begins:** This will ensure your speakers and mic are working properly before the live luncheon begins.
